



Wakefield North & South Division Campsite

Where is it?

Stocksmoor Road,
Midgley,
WF4 4JQ

The campsite is in the small village of Midgley next to the Stocksmoor Common Nature Reserve. It's very close to the Yorkshire Sculpture Park and the National Coal Mining Museum.

There's a convenience shop and pharmacy 1.3 miles away in Netherton, otherwise the nearest shops and GP are 3 miles away in Horbury.

What's it like?

The **main hut** has one large room with tables and chairs and a small fully stocked kitchen.

The **smallwood hut** has games and equipment for lighting fires and outdoor cooking.

The **toilet hut** has four chemical toilets and three wash cubicles.

A large **field** surrounded by trees.

Who can use it?

Anyone! It's suitable for all members of Girlguiding, but we also take bookings from Scouts or third parties.

There's enough space to support about 24 campers, or 12 sleeping on the floor of the hut.

What can I do there?

Perfect for:

- Summer evenings
- Wide games
- Unit camps
- Duke of Edinburgh
- Skills builder days
- Patrol camping

Why not bring your **Rainbows** up to experience nature and burn off some energy?

Teach your **Brownies** how to build a campfire and see how many silly songs you can remember.

Get your **Guides** off their phones and back to basics. Have a traditional camp where the adventure comes from doing everything for themselves.

Use it as a base for **Rangers** to walk the Calder Valley.
