## Overview of the campsite

The campsite is a greenfield site set on the edge of the Wakefield Metropolitan District. Situated approximately 5 miles from Wakefield, the campsite is in a nature conservation area (Stocksmoor) and situated well for visiting the Yorkshire Sculpture Park, Bretton County Park, Kirklees Light Railway, the National Coal Mining Museum and Pugneys Water Park.

- The camp site is approached from Stocksmoor Road (B6117). It has good access from either direction with car parking for four/five cars at the entrance to the site access road.
- The site is entered via a wooden five bar gate (there is also a smaller side gate). The catches are difficult to use but the gate swings open freely when pushed, it is propped open by a "brick" to stop it swinging back.
- There is then a concrete road leading to another parking area for further four/five cars. The road then leads to the main camp area. At the end of the road there is also parking for two/three cars. Please note: This access road is also used by agricultural vehicles
- The site consists of a large open green space with one large wooden hut and two smaller wood huts. There is also another wooden building which is the toilet wash block.

The site is not wheelchair friendly
